"Danish Grandparents Campaigning for Refugee Children" will demonstrate in Nytorv, central Copenhagen at 4 pm, 26 January 2016 against the bill before the parliament that very day. The legislation aims to punish the children by separating them from mum and dad for minimum 3 years, and by forcing them to live in comfortless camps.

The government intends to demonstrate to asylum seekers that refugees are not welcome in Denmark.
